



## INFORMATION ABOUT THE OPERATION OF CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) IN THE LIBRARY

The Library and Information Centre of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (H-1051 Budapest, Arany János street 1.) operates CCTV in order to protect life, health, and property by preventing accidents, thefts, and other crimes and providing evidence in criminal cases.

Our regulation of gathering, storing and retaining CCTV images is based on the following laws and regulations:

- *Act CXXXIII of 2005 - Security Services and the Activities of Private Investigators*
- *EU Regulation 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR)*
- *Act CXII of 2011 - Right of Informational Self-Determination and on Freedom of Information*

Scope of data: images of data subjects and other personal information. Please note that there is a 'CCTV in operation' sign at the entrance. By entering the building, you give your explicit consent for us to process your personal data.

The CCTV operates 24/7, capturing images. The footage is retained for 3 workdays. The live feed and recorded images may be inspected exclusively by the specifically authorized staff of the Library with their personal user name and password.
